TARPREC ApS is a Danish-based company based in Vejle, which focuses on re-cycling of soft PVC material, which is no longer serves its intended purpose useful for its original function. We collect used trailer tarpaulins/curtains and other similar soft PVC material. The PVC which we collect is upcycled into various useful products such as computer sleeves, purses, shopping bags, backpacks etc. The way we ensure to increase the life as well as the functionality of the material while guaranteeing a environmentally approach in our value chain. Only 10% of the material we receive will be deposited. The remaining 90% is either upcycled into new products or recycled and used again for other purposes. TARPREC is constantly developing as a company and seeking to make the remaining 10% of the collected material useful as well.

Our vision is to collaborate with several national and international companies that share the same interests, values and visions of a more sustainable future.

Since the spring of 2001, all Danish municipalities have collected PVC material in order to prevent it from being burned, as the incineration of the PVC creates hazardous toxins. Even though the municipalities are heavily investing in disassembling the material in a proper manner, the Danish Environmental Protection Agency nevertheless estimates that more than 50% of the PVC material enters the combustion plants, thus being discharged into the air.

Therefore, TARPREC has assumed an important role in society as we ensure that the PVC material is not incinerated. We focus instead on re-upcycling it. We want to contribute to the environmental problems that are damaging our planet and ensure that the problem is not passed on to other countries. Thus, it is important that our partners share the same values and visions of a sustainable business approach. We believe that all parties have a responsibility to contribute to a sustainable future.
